

# PREPARE TO BE FLOORED.

## Antique White Oak



Traditional white oak tones burnished with antique character.

The sapwood is lighter than the hardwood, which is a light tan to yellow-brown. White oak is usually straight grained, but can be often irregular or cross-grained. It has a slightly less coarse texture than red oak and has been widely used throughout history as a cornerstone wood for most any application.

### Flooring/Paneling

Great on walls and ceilings, perfect for floors!

Random Widths ..... 3"-5", 3"-7"  
Specified Widths ..... 3"-7"  
Thickness ..... 3/4", 5/8", or 1/2"  
Lengths ..... 2-12' Random or Specified Lengths  
Milled Profile ..... Tongue and Groove, Square or Shiplap  
Edges ..... Square or Pillowed  
Finish ..... Pre Finished or Unfinished

### Stair Treads and Parts

We'll glue, sand and cut to size to your design specifications, and shape your treads with a variety of edges.

Finish ..... Pre Finished or Unfinished

### Wood Tops

Countertops, table tops, and bar tops all shaped to suit with a variety of edges.

Thickness ..... 1 1/2", 2"  
Edges ..... Eased or Milled Profile  
Finish ..... Pre Finished or Unfinished

### Cabinet Lumber

Kiln dried, rough planed and straight line ripped on the inch, same widths as flooring/paneling.

Thickness ..... 4/4, 8/4, 10/4
