Antique White Oak



Traditional white oak tones burnished with antique character.

The sapwood is lighter than the hardwood, which is a light tan to yellow-brown. White oak is usually straight grained, but can be often irregular or cross-grained. It has a slightly less coarse texture than red oak and has been widely used throughout history as a cornerstone wood for most any application.
